



## GIVING WITH FAITH



With the support of San Pablo Lutheran Church (El Paso), Associate Pastor John Benito Morejón visits La Santa Biblia every Wednesday morning to feed spirits and minds with God's Word, prayer, and music. Afterwards, food supplied by YLM and other local Juarez charities, are given to about twenty-five families. "The need for food and God's Word doesn't stop," Rosy Lira, La Santa Biblia's deaconess, stated on a Friday morning, "This pandemic shows us there's a great need for what we give, so we give what God provides."

YLM partners with mission-churches, in El Paso and Juárez, from several distinct communities. Catechism classes, pastoral counseling, materials, hospital and jail visitations, are among the areas of ministry provides. Prayerfully consider **sponsoring** a partner congregation by donating \$1,000.

### **RADIO PROGRAM**

#### **BIBLES** BEHIND BARS

COVID-19 restrictions have kept YLM's Lutheran Prison Ministry servants from their weekly visits to bring God's love and joy in Word and music, but it hasn't stopped the gift of physical Bibles and Christian literature from being distributed.

Over 92 Bibles (English and Spanish), along with over t40 bilingual devotional materials and 110 songbooks, have been taken to the Detention Center in the last few months.

"We may not be able to be there personally, or virtually," Pastor Heimer shared, "Put we are there in spirit through prayer and will keep bringing God's Word to the nations at the Detention Center until we can return."



# LUTHERAN PRISON MINISTRY

Bibles and Christian literature is provided to inmates and immigration detainees. Services for men and women will be held weekly once COVID-19 restrictions are lifted. Through the Lutheran Prison Ministry, those behind bars throughout the United States will receive Bibles upon request.

# BLESSED WITH POTATOES!



Through Orphan Grain Train, we received over 42,000 pounds of potatoes! Over 40,000 potatoes were distributed among other community organizations, in El Paso and Juárez, to help individuals and families dealing with food insecurity, including migrant populated shelters in Juárez.

The San Pablo Pantry-YLM Emergency Food Program continued working through the COVID-19 restrictions, not once stopping, to give food to over 1,000 families every month, with more families seeking help every week.
