For the last year, Ysleta Lutheran Mission has moved forward with the combined leadership of the Board of Directors and Interim Executive Director, Karla Gonzalez. When asked why she dedicates her life, talents, and time to God's mission at YLM, Karla heartfeltly answered: "Who would have thought, on a Saturday when I was six years old, members from my congregation would show up at our house with a much-needed food basket? God answered my prayers that day, and since then, He set me apart for His mission, especially here on the border."

God brought Karla to YLM in October of 2006. For eighteen years, Karla has been learning, growing in her faith, and developing leadership skills through YLM's missional work. When she first started at YLM, she was tasked with front desk duties and translating Bible studies to Spanish. Pastor Heimer recognized her servanthood attitude and began teaching her of God's mission for a lost world through His Church. She took his teachings to heart, remembering herself as a kid who came to know, love, and serve God because of God's mission carried out by the church.

Eighteen years of faithful service, growth, and preparation equipped Karla to navigate the changes YLM has undergone since Pastor Heimer's retirement in 2023, whom she regards as a mentor. Now, with joy and faith, she leads YLM during this time of transition, full of hope, enthusiasm, and care, all of which are core to YLM's mission.


### The Heart of Ministry at YLM


Kaye Hartmann and Jerry Wick attended the Higher Things Conference in June, hosted by Concordia University in Mequon, WI.

Support the effort to teach guitar, violin, and trumpet to children and adults by donating to our music ministry, Adelante Ministries.



## Together in Mission

The importance of unity in fulfilling the Great Commission (Matthew 28:19-20) has been the foundational goal for YLM's Interim Executive Director, Karla Gonzalez. Collaborating with local churches, LCMS districts, and the Mexico Lutheran Synod, new relationships are forming to further the Church's mission.

In early April, three Texas District pastors visited YLM, touring the campus and learning about ministries assisting churches in sharing the Gospel. They witnessed a house-build by a Servant Event team at KM30, seeing firsthand the impact of acts of kindness.

A Missions Forum at Zion Lutheran Church in El Paso facilitated communication between Rio Grande Circuit churches and Texas District pastors, discussing strategies for Spanish-speaking outreach. YLM offered resources such as their music ministry, Servant Event ministry, and a bilingual podcast to facilitate Hispanic Ministry.

Karla and Pastor Misael Tovar attended the Mexico FORO in Mexico City, sharing YLM's commitment to supporting churches through resources and partnerships needed to serve their community. YLM will host the next Mexico FORO in October in continuation of their collaborative mission work.
