EAGER TO LEARN

It is always a difficult decision for parents in Mexico when it comes to sending their kids to school. Despite the "free education" Mexico offers, public schools charge fees for registration, and with added expenses of uniforms, school books, and school supplies, **families in impoverished towns like Anapra cannot afford an education for their children AND basic needs for their families, such as housing, food, and medical care.**

Give a new backpack filled with school supplies for one child with \$50 or have brand new backpacks delivered to YLM through www.bagsinbulk.com for the 2023 Back to School Distribution.

Many children in Mexico have to give up school by the time they're 11 due to the expense of continuing education past 6th grade. **Prayerfully consider sponsoring a Stay in School Scholarship (\$700) to help children and youth pursue a brighter future.**

LOVING THE FOREIGNERS AMONG US



Since April 2020, partnering Mexico **mission-church Iglesia Luterana San Lucas, has housed and served over 120 refugees** from Guatemala, Cuba, Salvador, and most recently, Haiti. The dormitories at San Lucas have been in use since then, and many repairs have been needed to keep refugees safely sheltered.

To continue offering Refugee Care, an estimated \$3,000 is needed each month to cover costs of building maintenance, utilities, transportation, and travel assistance for those who complete their US entry process.

Prayerfully consider being a part of the continuation of this ministry to help offer a safe place of refuge to displaced migrants in Juarez and El Paso.

Our Needs: We have specific needs for the following: roofing materials to repair rain damage, air conditioners, heaters, twin size mattresses, linens, First Aid kits, cleaning supplies. Call **(915) 858-2588** for more information on how else you can help offer God's love to refugees.

SENT TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE

Year-round, we welcome mission teams throughout the United States; adults, teenagers, and families with children as young as eight years old, eager to serve. Whether in El Paso or Juarez, they come to love and serve God and others, furthering the kingdom work being done through YLM.

In August, **three members of Hales Corners Lutheran Church** from Hales Corners, WI, did the trip down to El Paso, where their unique skills in project management helped YLM further **develop a vision for a future education community center in Anapra**. They also helped re-build the porch of one of San Pablo's long-time volunteers in nearby Clint, Texas.

October was a wonderfully busy month, with **Holy Trinity Lutheran Church** from Edmond, OK, spending their mission week in Anapra, where they **built a house for a family** of nine living in a house with a single bedroom. They provided VBS for over thirty kids every morning at Iglesia Luterana San Lucas as well.

Faith Lutheran Church from Branson, MO, has been serving through YLM for five years, and their team of ten came prepared to **help build a house** for David, Citlali, and their two daughters. The team worked efficiently and kept one day ahead of schedule, allowing for multiple opportunities to connect with the family, especially their two little girls.

Kathy Meyer, a registered nurse in Minnesota and Texas, brought her equipment, and her long-time friend Jayne Kurpius, to set up Foot Care Clinics. Three clinics were held on the YLM campus, where **thirty people received her specialized care**. On Wednesday morning, Kathy and Jayne took the Foot Care Clinic to Anapra, serving twenty people at La Santa Biblia and San Lucas.

FEEDING A MULTITUDE



In 2021, close to **26,000** individuals in El Paso alone **received food baskets through the Food Ministry at YLM**. This **2022**, we are up to **22,000** individuals and the year still has 7 weeks left before the winter break. **Over 20,000 pounds of food donated through Orphan Grain Train and Quality Fruits and Vegetables Inc.** have been sent to Mexico for families in crisis in Anapra and the sierras of Chihuahua.

Prayerfully consider helping feed a family of four for \$50

once again, offering the opportunity to purchase certain food items, such as poultry, meat, dairy and eggs, at a low-cost. Donate towards the Food Ministry, making it possible for these special food items to be given out on Saturday mornings.

YLM RADIO MINISTRY

The weekly radio ministry **hosted by YLM pastors, staff, and guest speakers**, has brought the Good News of Christ to people living in the Border. Scriptural guidance is given to people living in the Border, as well as connections to YLM services and missional ministries.

JOY DISTRIBUTION



For over twenty-five years, YLM has been working with hundreds of supporters to provide toys for impoverished children in El Paso and Juarez. An estimated 1,000 toys are given out every year, and in the last two years, over 1,100 kids received brand-new toys. **This year, our Joy Distribution on December 17th is expected to give toys to 1,500 kids** and we need your help to make it happen.

Prayerfully consider giving \$15 (or more) towards this year's Christmas toys for boys and girls of 18 months to 12 years. You can also send gift cards (VISA, MasterCard, Amazon, Target, Walmart) or new toys ranging from \$12-\$15.


Santa Biblia/Cristo Rey Needs:

As the most active mission-church in Anapra, the blessing of one of YLM's vans has helped in transporting and distributing thousands of pounds of food, over two thousand backpacks, and close to three thousand toys and jackets since they received it in 2019. They need a second van to transport elderly people to/from church as well as the deaconesses and volunteers.

Santisima Trinidad Needs: New tin metal roof for the small warehouse and a new roof for the shop.

Gloria Dei Needs: Pastor Misael Tovar continues to need a 4-wheel drive JEEP to reach out to the Tarahumara Indians. Due to Mexico importation requirements, the JEEP needs to be a make and model from the United States, Canada, or Mexico and produced before 2017.


